ORAL PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- The time allocated for each presentation is 20 minutes including Q&A (Presentation: 15 mins, Q&A: 5 mins)
- Presenters should speak in English for the presentation. (*except the Turkish Speakers*)
- Presentation slides must be in English. (*Including Turkish Presentations*)
- Supported file types for the presentations are Microsoft Power Point 2010/2013 version, Adobe Acrobat Reader and Windows Media Player.
- Presenters has to submit their presentation at least 2 hours before their session to [the Session Control Center](#). Presentations will be delivered to the related Session Hall from the Session Control center.
- Presenters are prohibited from using personal computers at the session rooms for their presentations.
- We kindly ask presenters to be in the session hall at least 5 minutes before the session starts.
- We kindly ask presenters not to leave the hall until the session finishes. Additional questions may be asked.
- Presenters should contact chairs of session and inform about they participate the session (they are at the hall) at least 5 min ago

POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- Please note the dimensions of the Poster has to be as: Width: 70 cm / Height: 100 cm
- Mount your posters from 09:00 on September 29th to 11:00 on September 30th and remove them latest at 19:00 on October 3rd. Posters not removed by this time will be discarded.
- There is not a poster session slot in the scientific program. Posters will stay on the boards for all Congress Days.
- Place the title of your paper clearly at the top of the poster to allow viewers to easily identify your paper. Indicate the authors' names and address information in order to allow interested viewers to contact you for more information.
- Organize the poster in a way that it is clear, orderly, and self-explanatory. The poster must cover the same content as the abstract.
- Prepare the poster with minimum font size for all text: 18 pt. Text and graphics must be readable from 2 meters away.
- Remember that the poster will be available for viewing and discussion for several hours. The poster should be understandable without oral explanation.
